"TIMES TO COME"

Dear Friends:

Every once in a while I like to look ahead and get all of you prepared for the days to come.

We look forward to the time of considering those who have gone before us, and how much we owe to them. Those who wish to remember their departed can pick-up All Souls intention envelopes in the back of the Church, and leave them with us in the collection or with me.

The All Saints schedule is different this time. There will be a Vigil Mass in Pine Plains at 7 pm on Monday, October 31st. On November 1st, Tuesday, Mass will be at 8 am and 7 pm. for the All Saints celebration in Immaculate Conception.

Then All Souls will be celebrated at 8 am and 7 pm in Amenia and at 12 noon in Pine Plains on Wednesday, November 2nd. At the 7 pm Mass we will remember those in our parish who have died in the past year.

On November 5th and 6th we will have a special collection for Father Godfrey and his Seminary in Nigeria. Father Godfrey has told me that they need help with building up the parking and road services at the seminary. You will hear more about his plans at the Masses. We here at Immaculate Conception-St. Anthony parish have been helping Fr. Godfrey for years as he has built a seminary in Nigeria filled with young men discerning the priesthood.

Please note in your calendars the last week of November (Nov. 28, 29, 30 and December 1st) which is also the 1st week of Advent, there will be a special Mission in our cluster parishes on the evening of those days. This is a special effort on the part of the Archdiocese to continue building up our clusters. Our cluster includes Pleasant Valley, Millbrook, our Parish, and Dover/Pawling. Please make all evening sessions if you can.
